
Smart-UPS Rack-Mount (5.25 inch models)




Smart-UPS Rack-Mount (8.75 inch models)


1. To remove the front panel, insert a screwdriver into the notch on the bottom of the unit. Forcefully tap the screw driver to unsnap the front panel off of the unit. Remove the screws from the back panel of the unit.



2. Remove the side panels.




3. Detach the red and black wires from the battery. Remove the old battery and replace with new battery. Reconnect the battery wires, red to the + and black to the -. Reassemble the unit.




BX650xx-xx

1. Remove screws from bottom of the front panel of the UPS. Slide the front panel upwards to remove it.



2. Detach the red and black wires from the battery.



3. Replace with a new battery. Connect the wires: red to the "+" terminal and black to the "-" terminal. Reassemble the UPS.
